Preparing for your new puppy!

A comprehensive list of items you will need before bringing your puppy home.



Puppy Food

We will send a bag of the food along with you of the food that your puppy is currently eating. If you decide not to continue with the kind we use, we recommend you slowly change over to the kind you want to use ongoing, by mixing the two kinds and slowly adding less and less of the current food.

Food & Water Bowls

You will need a bowl for each, so that he can have constant access to water. Heavier bowls put on a mat will help keep the bowls at one place instead of sliding around.

Collar, Leash & ID tag

It's important to have a well fitted collar for your puppy. Also ID tags on your puppy will be very valuable if he gets lost. There are several kinds of leashes to consider. Leash training is important to start from day one. Here is a great guideline site with info on the different collars and leashes available and why or when to use them.
